Ways to Downgrade or Upgrade Your Operating System

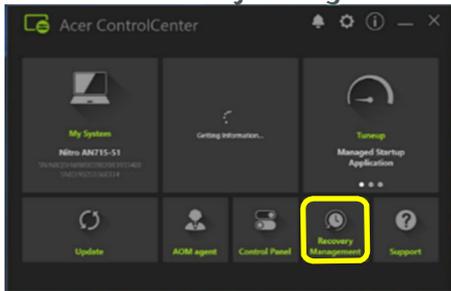
- I. **Via Acer's Recovery Management:** Acer's Recovery Management is a software program for Windows that comes with Acer's commercial PCs. For users entering the full Operating System environment after signing into their PC, Acer's Recovery Management allows them to reinstall Windows and restore their system settings.
- II. **Using the <Alt>+<F10> keys:** For IT administrators and advanced users entering the Bios environment without signing into their PC, use the Alt+F10 shortcut keys during boot up to quickly enter into the recovery environment of Acer's Recovery Management.

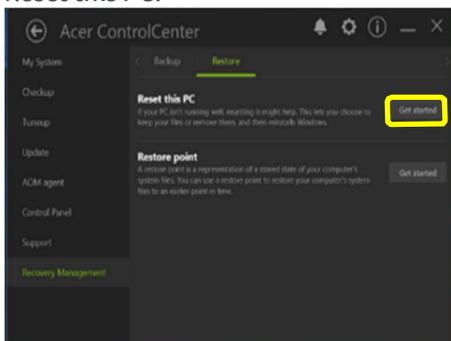

I. Via Acer's Recovery Management

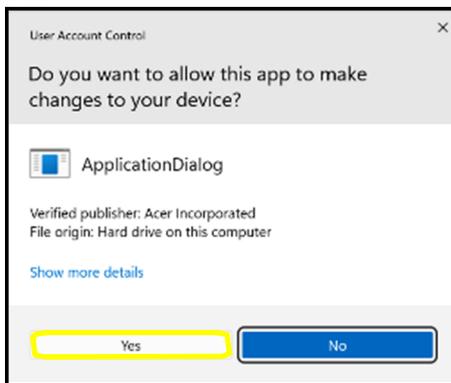
- From the *Start* menu, select **Control Center** then click **Recovery Management**.



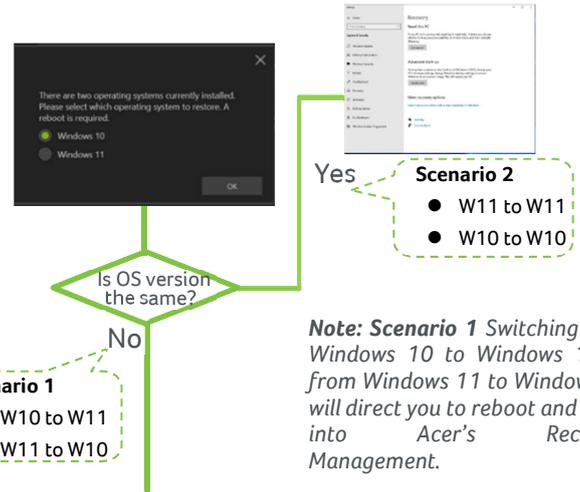
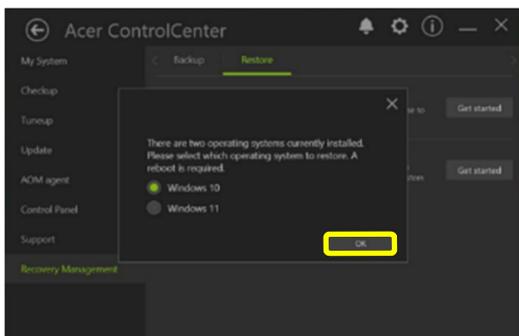
- Select **Restore** then click **Get started** next to **Reset this PC**.



- If your PC prompts you *Do you want to allow this app to make changes to this device?* Select **Yes**.



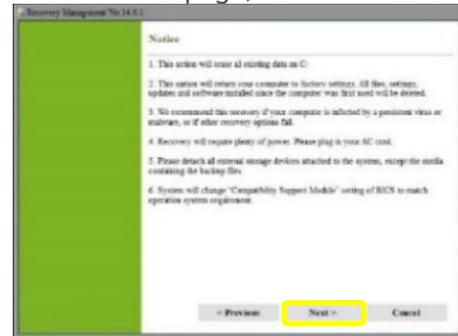
- You will be asked which operating system you want to install. Select **Windows 10** or **Windows 11**, then press **OK**.



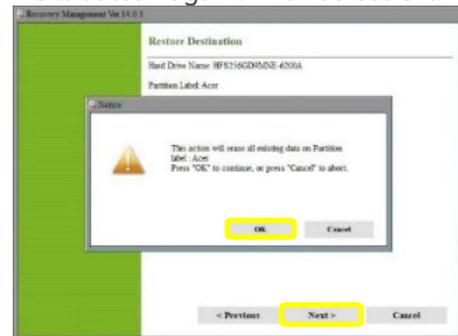
Note: Scenario 1 Switching from Windows 10 to Windows 11 or from Windows 11 to Windows 10 will direct you to reboot and enter into Acer's Recovery Management.

Note: Scenario 2 Switching from Windows 11 to Windows 11 or from Windows 10 to Windows 10 will direct you to Windows' Recovery page.

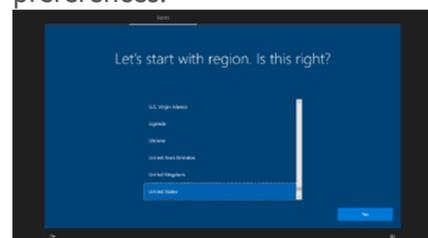
- On the *Notice* page, select the **Next** button.



- On the *Restore Destination* page, select the **Next** button again. Then select **OK**.

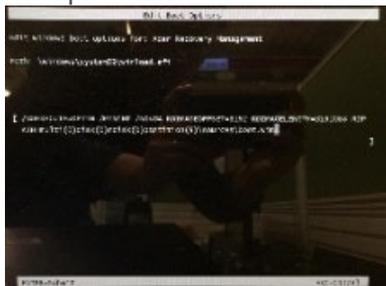

II. Using the <Alt> + <F10> Keys

1. Run Acer's Recovery Management during the boot up of your PC by pressing <Alt> and <F10> at the same time when the Acer logo appears on the screen.
2. If your PC has a hidden partition, pressing <ALT>+<F10> will direct you to *Select Restore Type* page. Select **Restore Operating System to Factory Defaults** link.

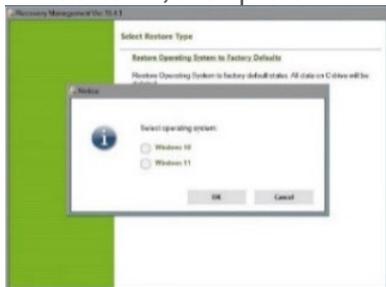


3. After the *Edit Boot Options* screen appears, then press **Enter**.

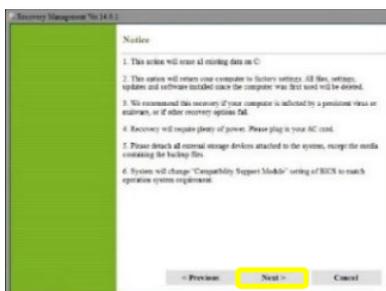


Note: If there is no hidden partition, the Windows' Recovery Environment page will appear after pressing <ALT>+<F10>. Then follow all on-screen instructions.

4. You will be asked which operating system you want to install. Select **Windows 10** or **Windows 11**, then press **OK**.



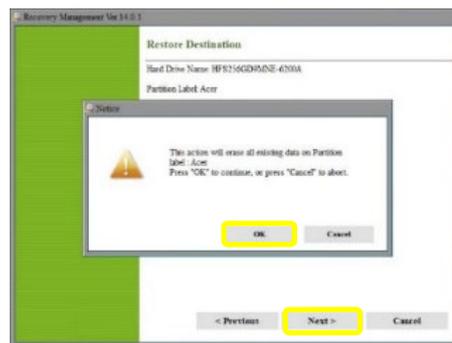
5. On the *Notice* page, select the **Next** button.



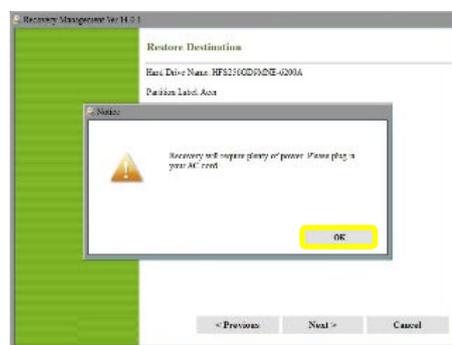

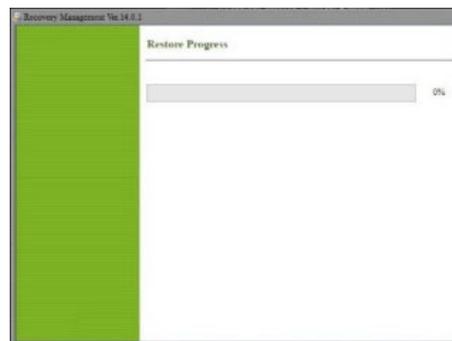
6. On the *Restore Destination* page, select the **Next** button again. Then select **OK**.
