

In [EFI Shell]

- 1.1 Get Acer BIOS Package.
- 1.2 Copy "EFI" and "ROM" folders including files to a EFI Shell bootable drive.
- 1.3 Power on System and press during POST LOGO to entry BIOS setup.
- 1.4 Set [Authentication]->[Secure Boot]->Disable.
- 1.5 Press <F10> or select [Exit]->[Save & Exit Setup] to save changes.
- 1.6 Boot to EFI Shell.
- 1.7 Key in 'cd EFI' (Go to Shell path, e.g. "fs0:\EFI")
- 1.8 Key in 'flash.nsh' or 'flash' and following pictures are reference only.

fs0:\> cd EFI

fs0:\EFI> flash

- 1.9 Press <Enter> and start to flash System BIOS.
